VA Benefits Are you or a loved one eligible for VA Benefits that pay for senior care? We can help

determine if you meet the four criteria of the VA Aid and Attendance Benefit.

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Benefit Amounts



Surviving Spouse	\$1,478	Married Veteran (spouse needs care)	\$1,806
Single Veteran	\$2,300	Married Veteran (with care needs)	\$2,727

*Actual benefit amount determined by the VA based on eligibility.

Eligibility Criteria



Military History

Veterans must have served 90 days of active duty with 1 day during a period of war. An honorable, general, or medical discharge is required.



Medical

The Veteran or spouse has cognitive or physical impairments that require the assistance of another individual on a regular basis.



Income

If care expenses exceed income, the maximum benefit will be awarded; most individuals receiving senior care meet this qualification.



Net Worth

The VA considers assets in making its determination; with proper planning, most can become eligible.
